

 **Family Thought:**


Where is God asking you to share His love this week?

His Call, Our Response

1 **A Big Vision**

As a family read through Isaiah 6:1-3

Isaiah saw something amazing—God sitting on a huge throne, shining brighter than anything he had ever seen! Angels flew around Him, calling out, “*Holy, holy, holy!*” That word *holy* means perfect and set apart. Isaiah realized just how big and powerful God really is.

When we think about God, it can remind us that He is greater than anything else in our lives—greater than sports, toys, or even our biggest worries.

 **Family Thought:**

What do you think it would be like to see God’s throne?

How does remembering that God is holy help you trust Him?

 **Prayer:**

God, You are holy and powerful. Help me remember You are greater than anything I face today. Amen.

2 *Isaiah Feels Small*

As a family read through Isaiah 6:4-5

When Isaiah saw God's holiness, he felt very small. He said, "Woe to me! I am ruined! I am a man of unclean lips." Isaiah realized that he wasn't perfect. He had made mistakes, just like we all do.

But the good news is that God doesn't leave us stuck in our sin. When we see how holy God is, we also get to see how much we need His forgiveness.

Family Thought:

What are some ways you've messed up and needed forgiveness?

How does it feel to know God sees you and still loves you?

Prayer:

Lord, I know I make mistakes. Please forgive me and remind me of Your love. Amen.

3 *God Forgives*

As a family read Isaiah 6:6-7



Something incredible happened next! An angel touched Isaiah's lips with a coal from the altar and told him his sins were forgiven. God didn't push Isaiah away—He made him clean and gave him a fresh start.

That's what Jesus does for us. When we ask Him to forgive us, He wipes away our sins. No matter what we've done, He gives us a clean heart and a brand-new start.

Family Thought:

How does it make you feel knowing Jesus forgives every sin?

Who can you forgive like Jesus forgives you?

Prayer:

Thank You, Jesus, for forgiving me and giving me a new start. Help me forgive others too. Amen.

4 *Send Me!*

As a family Read Isaiah 6:8

After God forgave Isaiah, He asked, "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?" Isaiah didn't wait—he said, "Here am I. Send me!" Isaiah was ready to do whatever God wanted because he was thankful for God's grace.

God calls us too! He wants us to share His love with others—in our family, our school, our neighborhood, and even on our team or at the playground. When we say, "Here am I, send me," we are choosing to live for something greater than ourselves.
